(MM.106 Rootstock)

Taylor's Sweet - Pink stripes on yellow background, medium size, from Somerset, more sweet than acidic, early-September

Fillbarrel - Red splashed on a green background, large size, from Somerset, nice sweet/sharp balance, mid-September

Sherrington Norman - Pink splashes on a yellow background, medium to large size, from Somerset, tannic and sweet, mid- to late-September

Belle Fille - Gold stripes on a burgundy background, small, from Normandy, tannic and sweet, late-September

Ellis Bitter - Red, medium size, from Devonshire, mildly tannic, late-September

Redstreak - Deep red stripes on a yellow background, medium size, from Herefordshire, lightly tannic and sweet with some mild tartness, late-September

Rhode Island Greening - Green, large size, from Newport, RI, sharp but mellows in storage, late-September

Stoke Red - Brilliant red, small size, from Somerset, sharp, late-September

Sweet Coppin - Yellow with a pink blush, medium size, from Devonshire, pure sweet, late-September

Hubbardston Nonsuch - Bright red, large size, from Hubbardston, MA, nice sweet/tart balance, early-October

Medaille d'Or - Golden, very small, from Normandy, very sweet, early-October

Bouteille de Lisieux - Solid green with a pink blush, small to medium size, from Normandy, nice acid/sweet balance, mid-October

Fortune - Red splashed on green, large size, from Geneva, NY, perfect sweet/tart balance, mid-October

Chisel Jersey - Red stripes on dark yellow background, small, from Somerset, tannic and sweet, late-October

Harrison - Yellow, small to medium size, from New Jersey, perfectly balanced flavor, late-October

Newton Pippin - Greenish yellow with brown splash, medium size, from Long Island, NY, nice sweet/tart balance, early November

Pup's Jeannette - Pink splashes on a green background, large size, from Greenfield, NH, very sharp mellowing to sweet in storage, early November
